As the instructional leader of Al Iman School, the Principal inspires faculty and students to fulfill the school's mission by nourishing a climate of respect for others and respect for learning. The Principal supports high quality classroom teaching, vibrant extracurricular programs, and fruitful spiritual formation activities. The Principal assures the orderly functioning of the school and the cultivation of a school-wide Muslim identity.

The Principal exercises responsibility for teaching and learning by engaging faculty in the development and implementation of a rigorous, high school preparatory curriculum and by providing ongoing instructional feedback. The Principal is responsible for creating and sustaining a culture of continuous improvement that seeks the greater fulfillment of the mission. The Principal reports to the school Al Iman School Committee and actively collaborates with the other members of the school's leadership team.

Position Requirements:

- Master's degree and significant administrative experience in a middle school setting (preferred; or willing to pursue Master's Degree)
- Certification as a School Principal (preferred; or willing to pursue Certification)
- Minimum of 3 years of experience as an instructional leader
- Minimum of 10 years as a teacher
- Proficient in purposeful integration of technology
- Familiar with NC state education mandates and laws
- Commitment and capacity to serve and connect on a personal level with mission-appropriate, high need, low socio-economic status, students and their families.
- Demonstrated commitment to and appreciation for Islamic, faith-based education.
- Strong background in developing and implementing a rigorous, standards-based, high school-ready curriculum.
- Evidence of an ability to analyze and utilize data to increase student achievement.

- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Prior service in Al Iman School is highly preferable but not required.
- Strong history of the following activities:
 - Collaborating with the School Board and other administrative team members in determining and implementing strategic institutional initiatives.
 - Leading professional development for all faculty and staff.
 - Advocating, nurturing, and sustaining a school culture and instructional program conducive to student learning and staff professional growth.
 - Facilitating the curriculum development and mapping processes.
 - Facilitating student and faculty led events.
 - Ensuring management of the organization, operation, and resources for a safe, efficient, and effective learning environment.

This position is a twelve-month salaried position that begins in the Summer of 2019. Salary is commensurate with experience.
